Murray Webster is a seasoned London-based songwriter, educator, and performer whose multi-decade career bridges genres and generations. Raised on the iconic pop songs of the 1960s — and having seen The Beatles live at the Hammersmith Odeon — Murray's connection to timeless songwriting began early and has only deepened over the years.

He picked up the guitar at age 15 and quickly became fascinated with crafting songs that could evoke the same emotional impact as the music he grew up with. After cutting his teeth in cover bands during the 1970s, Murray began developing his own sound, blending the punch of New Wave with the emotional richness of soul.

In the 1980s, he emerged as a key figure in a successful Soul Jazz band, performing at renowned venues including The Astoria, Hammersmith Palais, Town and Country Club, the Bracknell Jazz Festival, and the Soho Jazz Festival — the latter captured by Channel 4 and broadcast at peak times. Their unique sound caught the attention of industry icons like Paul Weller and Gilles Peterson.

Murray's passion for songwriting led him beyond the stage and into the classroom. He studied the craft both in the UK and the U.S., participated in retreats with legendary artists such as Ray Davies, and ultimately earned an MMus in Songwriting from Bath Spa University. His academic insight now informs his leadership at LondonSongwriters.org, where he mentors the next generation of artists with the same thoughtful approach that defines his music.

Throughout his career, Murray has continued to write and record music across genres — from introspective folk to modern pop — always with an ear for emotional truth and lyrical craft. With new material on the horizon and a lifelong commitment to storytelling through song, Murray's journey is far from over — and the next chapter promises some of his most compelling work yet.

YOUR COULDN'T CARE LESS HEART - OUT MAY 9TH

Murray Webster's upcoming release is a powerful fusion of Blues, Soul, and Latin Jazz — a genre-bending piece that marries gritty emotion with elegant musicality.

Originally written as a Soul Jazz instrumental in 1986, the song has been reimagined with newly penned lyrics inspired by the golden era of Hi Records and the vocal stylings of Ann Peebles. The result is a timeless track that brings the groove and sophistication of vintage jazz into sharp emotional focus.

Sonically, the song nods to legends like Kenny Burrell and Steve Cropper, with a simple yet unforgettable Guitar and Horns riff anchoring the entire arrangement. While lyrically, it explores themes of strength, resilience, and emotional liberation in the face of heartbreak and mistreatment.




